



## Day camp and 2 day camp

Royal Leisure Centre are holding a fun and educational riding camp on the 19th - 21st July where you will have the opportunity to hear guest lecturers, have training sessions, work on your technique, and socialise! You will have the opportunity to use our great all-weather outdoor and grass arenas, and newly installed Andrews-Bowen indoor arenas, as well as access to the beautiful South Downs National Park. This is not just for show jumpers! There will also be flat work, and is open to all abilities.

There are two options on offer, either a day camp or a two day residential camp. These will include -

Day Camp - arrive on Saturday morning, schooling, Lunch followed by a talk, finishing with another opportunity for schooling before heading home. There will also be opportunity for free clear round in between clinic sessions.

Cost - £100. Price includes lunch

Two-day Camp - arrive Friday evening for BBQ and quiz night, Saturday morning after breakfast there will be an opportunity for schooling, followed by lunch and a talk. There will be further schooling and an evening demo. And then a chance to unwind and socialise in the clubhouse. Sunday will start with

- Casual clothes

- Overnight necessities and camping supplies

- Any alcoholic beverage you would like to have with your evening meals (we will supply soft drinks and tea and coffee)

All clinics are optional, and if there are any that you do not wish to participate in then you are welcome to use our other facilities or go hacking on the South Downs National Park.

A non-refundable deposit of 50% of the full cost is required upon registration. Please return registration forms as soon as possible to avoid disappointment as spaces are limited.

- 11. Correct British Standard headgear conforming to current standards to be worn at all times when mounted.**
